Ms. Mosquera-Bruno called the meeting of the Low-Income Housing Tax Credit (“LIHTC”) Qualified Allocation Plan (“QAP”) Task Force (“Task Force”) of the Connecticut Housing Finance Authority (“CHFA”) to order at 11:03 a.m. in the Boardroom of CHFA’s offices, 999 West Street, Rocky Hill, Connecticut 06067.

Ms. Mosquera-Bruno asked the members to consider the adoption of the minutes from the January 9, 2020 meeting.
