CHFA has been notified by the State Commission on Education regarding certified teachers eligibility criteria for the following Priority & Transitional School Districts, Subject Matter Shortage Areas, and eligible Alliance District subjects, effective with Reservations dated July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, for the CHFA Teachers Mortgage Assistance Program.

#### *Changes Noted*: 1. New Transitional School Districts. 2. The Technical Education and Career System (*formal title for Technical High Schools*).

Per Section 8-265pp of the Connecticut General Statutes (C.G.S.), a mortgage assistance program is provided for the purchase of a primary residence for certified teachers who:

- 1. are employed by Priority or Transitional School Districts; or
- 2. are employed by the Technical Education and Career System in a technical education and career school that is located in a Priority or Transitional School District; or
- 3. teach in a Subject Matter Shortage Area or eligible Alliance District subject, pursuant to Section 10-8b of the C.G.S.; or
- 4. graduated from a public high school in an Educational Reform District, as defined in Section10-262u of the C.G.S.; or
- 5. graduated from a historically Black college or university or a Hispanic-serving institution, as those terms are defined under the applicable federal laws.
