Subject: CHANGES TO CHFA'S TEACHERS MORTGAGE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Connecticut Housing Finance Authority (CHFA) was notified by the Connecticut State Department of Education of changes to shortage areas and Priority and Transitional School Districts for the Teachers Mortgage Assistance Program.

Mathematics and Science (Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, General Science and Physics), have been added as designated shortage areas based on the federally identified high-needs fields in schools that serve low-income students.

The Priority and School Districts also changed. Bloomfield was deleted and East Haven, Vernon and West Hartford have been added.

The CHFA website has been updated to reflect these changes which take effect immediately. A revised Statement of Eligibility has also been posted. Brochures are now available.
