- 8. CHFA DAP and Recapture Taxes (*Forms #051-0597 and #052-1195-S borrowers receives with the mortgage commitment (may be copied two-sided)*
- 9. Home Maintenance Checklist

Ensure all presenters sign the speaker's agreement. Create a group class file or place in a binder by month all required documentation: agenda; attendance sheet; class roster; evaluations; intake forms and signed privacy disclosures.

* If your agency would like to add additional handout materials, it must be pre-approved by CHFA in advance and at no additional cost to CHFA or the attendee. The total amount of the materials will remain at \$10 per household.

At the conclusion of class, attendees will receive the CHFA Pre-Closing Evaluation Form to complete and a certificate of completion.
