Commissioner Mosquera-Bruno called the meeting of the Low-Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) Qualified Allocation Plan (QAP) Task Force to order at 12:03 PM. A roll call of Task Force members was conducted and a quorum was present.

Ms. Nash Giovannucci summarized additional revisions to the draft 2026-2027 LIHTC QAP resulting from written comments received as well as testimony presented at the Public Hearing held on June 12th. Discussion followed.

Commissioner Mosquera-Bruno asked Task Force members to consider recommending the 2026-2027 QAP, as revised, to the Board of Directors for adoption.

By unanimous consent, LIHTC QAP Task Force members approved recommending, for the Board's consideration, adoption of the 2026 and 2027 Low-Income Housing Tax Credit Qualified Allocation Plan.

Commissioner Mosquera-Bruno asked Task Force members to consider the minutes of the May 20, 2025 meeting.

Upon a motion made by Mr. Ugalde, seconded by Mr. Hodges, the May 20, 2025 minutes were approved by unanimous consent.
