Upon a motion made by Mr. Ugalde, seconded by Commissioner Mosquera-Bruno, the Mortgage Committee members voted unanimously in favor of recommending the resolution for financing of Windward Apartments, Phase II, located in Bridgeport, Connecticut, to the Board of Directors for consideration.
