By video conference due to the COVID-19 public health crisis and in accordance with Governor Lamont's Executive Order 7B, Ms. DeWyngaert, Chairperson of the Mortgage Committee called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m. A roll call of committee members was conducted and a quorum was present.

Valencia Taft-Jackson presented the resolution to adopt amendments to the Single Family Housing Downpayment Assistance Program Procedures.

Upon a motion made by Mr. Ugalde, seconded by Ms. Clarke, the Mortgage Committee members voted by roll call and were unanimously in favor of recommending the resolution to the Board of Directors for consideration.

Joseph Voccio presented the resolution to approve the prepayment of two mortgage loans for Summitwoods, located in Norwich, Connecticut. He summarized the prepayment conditions which include CHFA's approval of the buyer and management agent, CHFA's continued compliance monitoring, and prior to closing, CHFA's acceptance of the final residual analysis. There was discussion regarding the performance of the project and the conditions that will be imposed on the prepayment and sale.

Upon a motion made by Mr. Ugalde, seconded by Ms. Clarke, the Mortgage Committee members voted by roll call and were unanimously in favor of recommending the resolution, with the conditions outlined, for prepayment of two mortgage loans for Summitwoods, Norwich to the Board of Directors for consideration.

Ms. DeWyngaert asked the Mortgage Committee members to consider the minutes from the November 19, 2020 meeting.

Upon a motion made Ms. DeWyngaert, seconded by Mr. Ugalde, the Mortgage Committee members were in favor of adopting the minutes of November 19, 2020. Ms. Gosselin abstained from voting.

Wendy Moores provided an update of recent multifamily activities which included staff's work on the 9% Low-Income Housing Tax Credit applications, a summary of initial and final closings, and staff's participation in overview sessions and workshops.

There being no further business to discuss, upon a motion made by Mr. Ugalde, seconded by Ms. DeWyngaert, the meeting adjourned at 9:29 a.m.
